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# Joint Commission International (JCI)

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- Division not-for-profit of The Joint Commission (TJC)
- JCI's mission is "to continuously improve the safety and quality of care in the international community through education, advisory services, and international accreditation and certification"

## **International standard JCI**

- In 1999 an international task force of 16 members (experienced physicians, nurses, administrators, public policy experts)
- members from six major world regions

## **JCI Standards characteristics**

- Number and Description
- Intent of Standard
- Measurable elements

# Joint Commission International (JCI)

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- International accreditation body
- since 1994 in more than 100 countries
- 940 accredited organizations (\*)
- JCI is accredited by the International Society for Quality in Health Care External Evaluation Association (IEEA)

# Management of Information (MOI chapter) - 1

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- qualified individual oversees health information technology systems (MOI.11)
- education and training on information systems, information security, and the principles of information use and management (MOI.6)
- information security risk assessment, at least annually (MOI.2.1)

# Management of Information (MOI chapter) - 2

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- proper use of copy-and-paste, auto-fill, auto-correct, and templates (MOI.8)
- mobile devices are used for texting, e-mailing, or other communications of patient data and information (MOI.12)
- a program for response to planned and unplanned downtime of data systems (MOI.13)
